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Introduction:

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is an international, independent, medical humanitarian organization that delivers emergency aid to people affected by armed conflict, epidemics, natural disasters and exclusion from healthcare. Project description:

This Request For Information (RFI) is a first step towards selecting a supplier in charge of analysing the current vehicle fleet management state of affairs. This RFI will be followed by an RFP. The shortlisted candidates will be given more information on the project during the second phase.

The objective of the selected supplier will be to find out through an analysis of the vehicle fleet management model and practice used in MSF if there are opportunities for efficiency and effectiveness gains. The current transport fleet of some 2 000 vehicles (majority of four wheel drive) in constant rising is divided in 60 countries.
